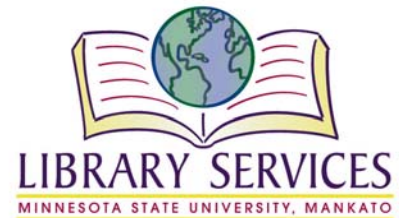




GOOD NEWS MARCH, 2005
