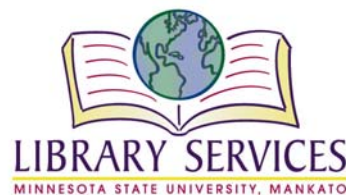




## GOOD NEWS November, 2006
