


Finding Books, Videos, and Other Library Items at MSU

View and renew checked out items and view current interlibrary loan requests





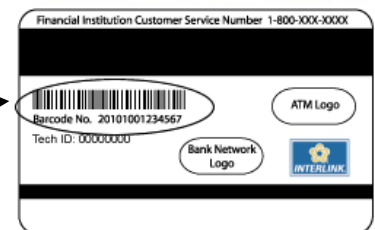

1. Select **My Library Account** from the Library homepage or **My Account** within the library catalog
2. To login:
 - a. Username is the 14 digit barcode number on the back of your MavCard or library card
 - b. Password is **either** your last name **or** the first 8 letters of your last name
3. Select the tab **Checked Out Items**
4. Click the **Renew This** link under each item to renew
5. Select **Log Out** from the top toolbar when you are finished
